

CHILDREN'S HOME

The children's home Kakanad is a shelter home under the department of women and children, Government of Kerala. This welfare home gives protection to the girl child up-to the age of 18. The department of women and child development provides policy guidance, designs targeted programs and protects for women and children, strengthens capacity development for gender and child rights mainstreaming, co-ordinates, monitors and evaluates effective service delivery for all the empowerment of women and children. The children's home Kakanad is exclusively for the rehabilitation of girls in need of care and protection.

Students of our college visited the children's home on 23-11-2017 as a part of B.Ed Curriculum. There is a big role a teacher to protect the children from violence, abuse and exploitation. There is some abuse that may happen inside the school premises, while a lot of it what children suffer at home and non-school environments. The visit to this shelter home indeed was an eye opener to the teacher trainees of our college to know the important and responsible role of a teacher towards the children. Our students interacted with the inmates of the shelter home, listened to their bitter experiences they narrated. There were children who are sexually abused by people at home and outside, girls who are trapped in sex rackets and also neglected by their parents.
